

SUSSEX DARTS ORGANISATION CODE OF CONDUCT

Squad members to wear black trouser/skirt at all times on match days

County match shirts must be worn while playing games

There is to be no Back Biting Via Facebook, twitter, e mail, text or any other way of communication, If you have a problem or disagree with a decision you should speak to a member of the Committee/Management.

When leaving the stage after your game you must show respect to your opponent and all Officials, If you need to let off steam shake hands then go out side, but do not slag off any player or Official.

Unseemly conduct at any match venue or hotel will not be tolerated.

Full attendance is expected at all matches (Named Players or Not), If you are unavailable for certain dates you must ensure the Committee/Management are notified in plenty of time with a valid reason.

All Players and Committee/Management must limit their alcohol intake on match days to a reasonable limit.

No alcohol is to be consumed on stage (BDO Rule) and no players should turn up ""Hung-over""

Coach and hotel booking for away matches must be confirmed at the match prior to the date, Once booked you are responsible for the booking and therefore agree to pay for it There will be no last minute changes to the bookings

Purchase of a program covering the entry fee for a match must be made by all Players/Officials & Supporters unless exempt

It is not a **(god given right)** to play for the County, It is ability and attitude,

It is the duty of all Players to assist on match days, When requested, with computer scoring, the Music player, Stage Calling, Fund Raising. At the end of the day clearance of the Equipment.

Respect, It Works both way , Treat people the way you expect to be treated.

And finally and most important enjoy your selves and enjoy your darts.
